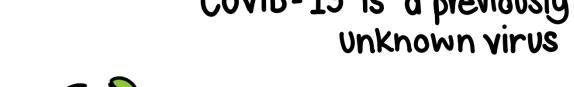
#### WHAT IS THE CORONA VIRUS?

The first cases were identified in Dec 2019.







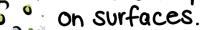
#### **HOW IS IT TRANSMITTED?**



Compared to other viruses, COVID-19 is large and heavy.



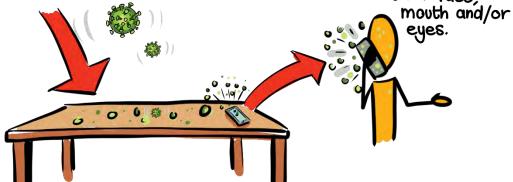
It spreads when an infected person talks, coughs or sneezes and the droplets fall



Touching these contaminated surfaces transfers these droplets onto the hands. People get infected when they touch their face,

Most infected people develop symptoms within 5-14 days of infection.









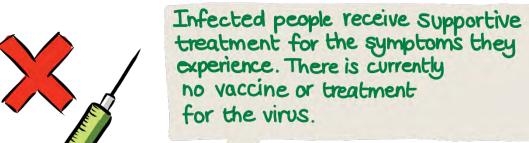
#### WHAT IS THE TREATMENT?

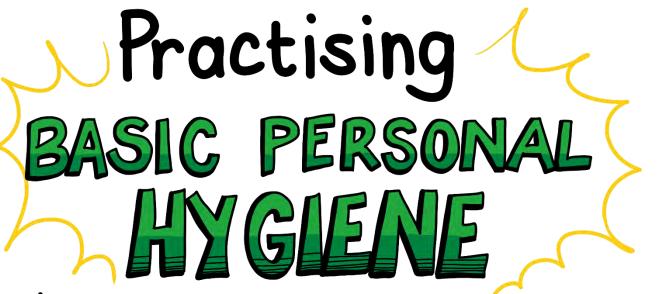
















is the most effective way of preventing the spread of COVID-19

If soap and water are not readily available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitiser



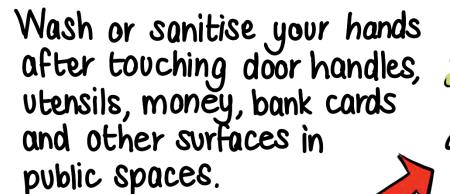






























Avoid sharing food cups, towels and personal utensils

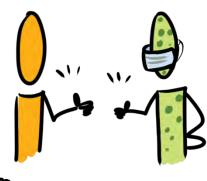
#### DID YOU KNOW?

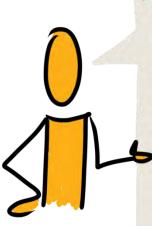
#### ONE LAST THING TO REMEMBER...

If we look after one another, we will get through this.









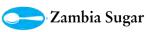














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
